





"Hang in There"

Do you ever have one of those days/weeks when it seems like nothing goes right for you? One work morning you wake and immediately notice that your alarm clock did not go off because of a power outage. You rush to get dressed, grab your car keys to sprint out of the house, a cup of coffee in your hand...and what happens next? Your coffee spills! After cleaning it up, you hear a "ding" in your car (*low fuel light!*) You finally get to work 45 minutes late, and as you walk in, everyone in the office is coming out of the 8 AM mandatory meeting you forgot about when you noticed the alarm clock did not go off. WOW!

Job was a blameless man who feared God. He loved his family and was the richest person in the region. Satan comes along and accuses God of having a hedge around Job, and if everything was taken away from him, he would surely curse God to his face. God lets Satan test Job, but He tells Satan not to harm him physically. So, Job loses everything...his children, his livestock...the only thing he didn't lose was his wife who advised him to, "Curse God and die!" (Job 2:9) Even three friends come to visit Job and decide he is suffering because he has sinned. (*Low time in Job's life!*)

But, what does Job do? He keeps his course, but how do you think he feels? Angry, confused, frustrated?
