Sinners or Saints?

are all sinners" as a justification for sin. The overall thought being that since we all sin we should not really be surprised or that upset to see sin in anyone's life. This is a complete abuse of the concept of sin in the life of a Christian and dishonest in regard to how the Bible would present this idea. It is true that we are all sinners if you mean by that statement that we all struggle with sin and that none of us have achieved perfection. (James 3:2, 1 John 1:8) It is not true that we are all sinners if you mean by that statement that there is no difference in the life of one who is in Christ and one who is outside of Christ. The Bible continually contrasts the idea of a man being either a sinner or a saint. The title of saint is used as a designation to describe those who are part of His Church and called out from the world. (Acts 9:32, Rom. 15:25, 1 Cor. 16:1) Christians err when they forget the significance of either of these words, sinner and saint.

Some are fond of using this phrase, "we

it is always unacceptable and something that ought to grieve us. Paul wrote about this dynamic in Romans 6 as some thought that grace and salvation of God could somehow be used as a justification for sin. The same arguments are still being made today. His response was, "God forbid" (Rom. 6:2). If that is what you think, you have missed the whole point of the gospel. His explanation is that "our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin" (Rom. 6:6). This means that sin is not an acceptable part of the Christian life. When it does still present itself in all of our lives it should frustrate us. Paul spoke of this reality in his own life of seeing sin when he did not want to see sin. His response? "O wretched man that I am!" (Rom. 7:24) This is the response that causes us to turn to Christ as the only one who can set us free.
