INTRODUCTION:

Any church not founded on Pentecost is not the true church. This is one of the tests by which to determine whether a church is the true church or not.

In looking for the scriptural church, look for these marks:

Built by Christ

Built on Christ

Built in Jerusalem on Pentecost

Any church that does not bear these marks, is not the church that Jesus said He would build. It may have many good people in it and may teach many good things, but it is not the church of the Bible.


