

PRUNED OR CUT OFF?

Have you ever had or currently have a garden that was full of flowers and roses? If so, what was the normal routine to maintain those flowers and roses? (I am not a gardener so please bear with me if I miss something). I believe you would do all you could to keep the flowers and roses growing and blooming so they would look beautiful during the year. What happens when you see that some of them for whatever reason have wilted or died? Normally, you would go out and cut off the dead or dying branches and continue to cut-back or **prune** the branches that are alive and well.

So, why do you do these two things?

- To the branches that have died or are dying. you cut them off because they are no longer a part of the vine and have no reason to continue being connected.
- If the branches are alive and well, you prune them or cut them back which helps maintain proper growth.

This is right in line with Jesus' words in the Bible. In John 15:1-6, He says, "I AM THE TRUE GRAPEVINE, AND MY FATHER IS THE GARDENER. HE CUTS OFF EVERY BRANCH OF MINE THAT DOESN'T PRODUCE FRUIT, AND HE PRUNES THE BRANCHES THAT DO BEAR FRUIT SO THEY WILL PRODUCE EVEN MORE...YES, I AM THE VINE: YOU ARE THE BRANCHES. THOSE WHO REMAIN IN ME. AND I IN THEM, WILL PRODUCE MUCH FRUIT, FOR APART FROM ME YOU CAN DO NOTHING. ANYONE WHO DOES NOT REMAIN IN ME IS THROWN AWAY LIKE A USELESS BRANCH AND WITHERS, SUCH BRANCHES ARE GATHERED INTO A PILE TO BE BURNED."

QUESTION: As we look at our lives and the way we live, are we being pruned, or are we eventually going to be cut off from the vine?
