

Jesus and Diseases

Sometimes we can get overwhelmed with announcements about who is sick, who is recovering from surgery, and who has passed away. It can be depressing and, at times, distracting from the good news of the gospel. In those moments, we must remember that one of the things that fulfilled Jesus' ministry was the care he gave to those who were sick and dying. The New Testament is filled with examples of Jesus healing lepers, causing the lame to walk, and making the blind see. In Matthew 8 Jesus finds himself in Peter's home and sees Peter's mother-in-law sick with a fever. Jesus heals her by touching her hand. That evening Jesus is busy healing many who were demon possessed by casting out the spirits with a word, and He "healed all who were ill." (Matt. 8:16) Matthew's analysis of all this healing is found in verse 17. He healed these people, "in order that what was spoken through Isaiah, the prophet, might be fulfilled, saying, 'He Himself took our infirmities, and carried away our diseases.""

When Jesus healed diseases, it was a fulfillment of everything He was intended to be. Today, when we visit the sick, pray for healing and comfort for those who are dealing with illness and surgeries, or take dinner to those who are too weak to help themselves, it is more than just a good thing. It is part of what the Church that belongs to Jesus is intended to look like. Jesus cared about people when they were facing earthly struggles. We care about people having those same struggles.

The beautiful thing is that miracles of healing opened doors for Jesus to provide real healing through living waters. Today when people see that the Church cares for them, it will also open doors to talk to them about their spiritual health and the disease of sin that Jesus has helped every Christian overcome.
