

Keep Planting Seed

I received this message yesterday from a friend who preaches in Missouri:

"Good morning! Please pass on this pleasing news to folks in Valdosta who would like to hear it. One of our elders, John Deffenbaugh, and I just returned from a weekend in Honduras. We were invited to be present and preach at a Sunday morning gathering of numerous churches in the

El Paraiso department. Folks at LAM were instrumental in the beginning of the Lord's work there in the early 1990s. The combined service Sunday morning numbered about 500 souls! It was the largest gathering in the history of the Lord's church there. Several people present became Christians during those earliest campaigns. Thanks to everyone who has planted seed and watered it in the communities there."

This message reminded me of Paul's words in 1 Corinthians 3:6, "I planted, Apollos watered, but God caused the increase." I have no idea who went on those early campaigns to Honduras, but it really does not matter. What matters is that the Word of God was planted in the hearts and minds of the people that lived there. I doubt that those on the early campaigns could have even imagined a gathering of 500 Christians there, but that is exactly what happened because of their work so many years ago.

Our job/opportunity is to **plant** the seed. Plant the seed in your family. Plant it at work. Plant it in your community. Plant it in foreign lands. Plant it everywhere you go. It may yield immediate results, or it might need someone to come along years later and water the seed. You may never know the good that is done for future generations by the work done today in planting God's Word. May we work today as God's vessels so that the growth of the Church in the future will be greater than we can even comprehend!
