

"But I say to you, do not resist him who is evil; but whoever slaps you on the right cheek, turn to him the other also." (Matt. 5:39) Christians should read those words over and over, but especially when someone does us wrong. Jesus did not only preach lofty ideas, but he lived them out and left us an example to follow. 1 Peter is all about what Christians ought to do when suffering in spite of or because of their righteousness. The great example is Jesus on the cross. "And while being reviled. He did not revile in return; while suffering. He uttered no threats, but kept entrusting Himself to Him who judges righteously."
