How To Respond

Frequently in life people can fail to show kindness when they interact with us. At times they can be harsh and act in ways that do not seem to match with our understanding of what we deserve. This can happen in dealing with the world and even our brethren in Christ. It is in those moments that our faith is really tested as we decide how we will respond. This article is in no way trying to justify unkind or harsh behavior; rather, its purpose is to focus on the one thing that we do control, our response. The human response is to fight back. If someone hits me, I want to hit them back. If someone says something ugly to me, I want to say something ugly back. Usually, there is a tendency to not only strike back but to do it with an increasing intensity. This response "makes sense" to us, but it is not the response of a Christian.

Jesus reminds us. "You have heard that it was said. 'An eye for an eye and a tooth for a tooth.' But I tell you not to resist an evil person. But whoever slaps you on your right cheek, turn the other to him also. If anyone wants to sue you and take away your tunic, let him have your cloak also." (Mathew 5:28-40) An example Jesus left for us to follow in this regard is 1 Peter 2:23. "Who. when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously." Do those responses sound like our responses with life and people who are not fair or kind?

Too often there is much time spent talking about the limits of these statements and not enough time talking about the application of what they do mean. May we be a people who are willing to actually suffer in doing what is right. (1 Peter 4:19)
