

Growth came in amazing ways through the impact of daily/weekly exposure and use of the Bible.

This growth that God desires to occur within every one of us is why it is important to read and meditate on God's word daily and be a part of our Bible Classes on Sunday and Wednesday night. The short justification I would give for you and your family's involvement in these things is that they make a difference. They cause your spiritual growth. It is also true that a failure to engage in these things fails to make a difference. This means that you fail to grow. Think about something that you learned in Bible Class last week, no matter how small. Now multiple this by the hundred Bible classes you will participate in over a year and the thousands of classes you will prepare for in a decade. Before you know it, you have been transformed from a boy who prays no one calls on him, to a man of God who is able to teach others. This is the kind of growth we should all strive for and be excited about. See you in Bible Class!
