Christians Like Hur

In Exodus 17 the Israelites are defending themselves against Amalek. While the soldiers were on the battlefield, Moses went to the top of the surrounding hill. Verse 11 tells us when Moses held his hands up, Israel prevailed in the battle; but when he let his hands down, Amalek started winning. That sounds like a simple plan to victory. Moses keeps his hands up, and Israel is victorious. It sounds like a simple plan until you try holding your arm up above your head for any length of time. This would be a challenge for even the most fit among us. If you don't believe it, try it! The solution to this problem is found in Exodus 17:12, "But Moses hands were heavy. Then they took a stone and put under him, and he sat on it; and Aaron and Hur supported his hands, one on one side and one on the other. Thus his hands were steady until the sun set."

Everybody knows who Moses was as he stood on the mountain with his hands held high. Most people will recognize Joshua as he fought in the valley below. Most of us have no idea who Hur is. The truth is that if he had not stood under Moses' arms to hold them up, the battle would have been lost. We need more Christians like Hur. Christians who may not stand in the forefront, but whose contributions are essential for success.

This last weekend we had a great Marriage Matters Weekend. There were a lot of people who stood out in front to make it happen. While all the activity was going on several of our girls were giving up their Friday and Saturday to watch children so that parents could focus on their marriages.
